Comparison of 2nd quarter 2010 vs 2nd quarter 2009

In 2nd quarter 2010, the Group's revenue increased by 12.5% to SS30 million due mainly to new acceptances. The net claims incurred rose 20.4% to S\$6.1 million due partly to higher precautionary reserves set up for certain regional markets. Consequently, an underwriting deficit of S\$233,000 was recorded as against the S\$131,000 profit in the same quarter last year. Net investment income grew 63.9% to S\$4.6 million, compared to S\$2.8 million in the corresponding quarter last year, attributed largely to higher profit on sale of equity investments. Overall, the Group reported higher profit before income tax of S\$4.7 million in 2nd quarter of 2010, an increase of 56.3% from the S\$3 million recorded in the same quarter last year.

Comparison of 6 months 2010 vs 6 months 2009

For the half year ended 30 June 2010, the Group's revenue increased by 21.8% to \$\$51.8 million, attributed to new business written and organic growth. Notwithstanding the steep increase in gross claims incurred, after taking into consideration potential reinsurance recoveries, the net claims incurred was 17.9% higher at \$\$9.1 million, attributed mainly to new precautionary reserves set up for certain regional markets. This represented an incurred loss ratio (of net written premium) of 43.6% as compared to 40.3% in the corresponding period last year and the underwriting surplus of \$\$809,000 was also lower than the \$\$1.3 million a year earlier.

The net investment gain rose 99.1% to S\$7.1 million due to profit on sale of equity investments and lower impairment write-down. Additionally, with improved contribution from the subsidiaries, the Group's net profit before income tax increased by a credible 67.4% to S\$8.8 million, compared to the S\$5.3 million in the first half of 2009.

An investment revaluation surplus of S\$2.5 million was reported in the Statement of Comprehensive Income and credited to the fair value reserve and therefore affect net asset value only.

In the opinion of the Directors, no item, transaction or event of a material and unusual nature has arisen in the interval between the balance sheet date and the date of this announcement which is likely to affect substantially the results of the operations of the Company and of the Group for the current financial year.

The reinsurance operating environment will likely remain extremely competitive thereby putting pressure on insurance premium rates and policy coverage, in light of the sustained global excess capacity. This would squeeze underwriting profitability margin which is further compounded by uncertainties associated with the unpredictable changes in climatic patterns. Notwithstanding Singapore's projected GDP growth estimate of between 13% and 15% for 2010, the Group remains cautious in an operating environment fraught with many uncertainties from both economic and underwriting perspectives.
